Meeting Minutes

President Sheila Terhune called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. There were 10 members present.

Fred Mosemiller, Secretary, read the minutes of the March 12th meeting. The minutes were approved as read.

Ralph Nichols, Treasurer, read the March financial report. In March, we had a gain of \$24.50 but a loss for the year thus far of \$98.98. The balance on hand at the end of March was \$12,512.35. The report was approved as read.

Sheila announced that Jack Robinson reports that Betty is now getting up and around and is having therapy in the hopes she can return home soon.

Old Business:

**The first of the four scheduled Plus Workshops drew 36 dancers; after the caller and room were paid for, we netted \$32.

**Nina reminded the Club that much of our income comes from our work at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway; only the gift shops are available for staffing this year. Nina is no longer in charge of this activity for IDA. Training on using the electronic pads for transactions will be at 9:00 a.m., on Saturday, April 25th, at the Brickyard Crossing motel; anyone planning to work this year is encouraged to attend the training.

New Business:

**Ralph will reserve the shelter house at the Franklin Park in Plainfield, but needs to know what date we would like. Because the Indiana State Museum Dance is scheduled for September 12th, it was decided to request Saturday, September 5th, from 4:00-8:00 p.m.

**Indy Parks now centrally controls when the heating/AC is turned on; if the room is too hot/cold, we need to let those at the Krannert desk know that we are uncomfortable so they can work to fix this.

**Dave Upton reminded the Club that he has been filing the exemptions for federal income tax, as we are a not-for-profit that does not receive a certain level of funding; filings are done twice each year and need to be done to keep our not-for-profit status. There is also a filing that is required annually by the Indiana Secretary of State. Sheila made a note of when these are required so that the deadlines are not missed.

Sheila adjourned the meeting at 7:05 p.m. Our next meeting will be at 6:30 p.m., Thursday, May 14th.
