December 12, 2019
Meeting Minutes

President Jerry Hale called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.; there were 11 members present.

Treasurer Lisa Dee Guy presented the Treasurer's report for November. Income was \$541.15 and expenses were \$862.35, for a loss for the month of \$321.20 and a gain for the year of \$314.09. Rosie Bishop moved that the report be accepted; Paula Egenolf seconded the motion; the report was accepted.

Substituting for Secretaries Fred and Marti Mosemiller, Marcia Elliott read the minutes of the November 14th meeting; Paula Egenolf moved the minutes be accepted; Donna Hale seconded and the motion was passed.

Cheer Committee head Marcia had three cards to be signed at the dance this evening for those in need of cheer: Wayne Moore, Jan Smith, and Rosezella Dietrich (former angel).

By a show of hands, it was decided to send our cuer Jan Smith a Christmas card with a gift of \$75; Lisa gave the money to Marcia who will then send the card and gift.

Jerry reported that the Krannert rental agreement has not arrived for 2020. The brochures which Sheila Terhune has printed up of our 2020 dances, with dates, themes and callers is available at our dances; this information is also on both the Club and IDA dance calendars. There will be no dance on December 26th nor lessons on December 24th or 31st. Our first dance for 2020 will be January 9th.

It was decided, after discussion, to give certificates to those completing Mainstream lessons on January 7, 2020, and then have a Graduation Party after completion of Plus lessons later.

Those requesting to be accepted as new members are Tom and Pam McCarthy, Gary and Deb Hutton, and Dave and Dana Danberry; a show of hands led to acceptance of these new members.

Jack will install the 2020 officers during the first meeting of the new year.

Paula Egenolf and Bill Garrison will be co-chairs of Publicity for the national convention to be held in Evansville in 2022. Paula said they will need many volunteers and is hoping Club members will help out; as many as 3000 dancers

are expected to attend. Sharon Roberts will serve as Legal Counsel for the convention.

Jack Robinson announced that an audit of the Club will occur in January.

Paula is planning to take photos at tonight's dance to post on our Club website; it will be announced before the dance starts that anyone not wanting their photos published should let Paula know.

After discussion on a possible fundraiser to increase our Club treasury, Jerry and Jack were tasked with exploring possibilities and reporting back to the Club.

Sharon moved and Rosie seconded that the meeting be adjourned; the motion passed and Jerry adjourned the meeting.
